WOMAN: Right children ... this morning we're talking about sport. Do you go to a sports centre, John?

BOY: Yes. I go every Thursday.

WOMAN: Every Thursday?

BOY: Yes, that's right. I love going there.

Can you see the answer? Now you listen and write.

1 **WOMAN:** Which sports centre do you go to, John?

BOY: It's called Park Sports Centre.

WOMAN: Park? How do you spell that?

BOY: You spell it P-A-R-K.

2 **WOMAN:** Do you do lots of sports there, John?

BOY: Yes, I do.

WOMAN: What's your favourite sport?

BOY: Swimming. I'm good at swimming. I can do it really well.

WOMAN: That's great.

BOY: All my family enjoy that sport.

3 **WOMAN:** And are you having any lessons?

BOY: Oh ... I'm having climbing lessons! It's a really exciting sport.

WOMAN: How can you have climbing lessons at a sports centre?

BOY: There's a wall there. It's difficult, and you must be very careful on it!

WOMAN: Wow!

4 **WOMAN:** Who goes with you to the sports centre? Your father?

BOY: No, my uncle. He takes me every week. We go in his sports car. He drives really quickly!

WOMAN: Does he?

BOY: Yes!

5 **WOMAN:** Would you like to learn another sport?

BOY: Yes. I want to learn to sail.

WOMAN: Do you?

BOY: Yes. You can learn to sail at the lake, but you can't do that at the sports centre.

- MAN:** Yes, you can.

- 2 **GIRL:** Which girl was the best dancer?
- MAN:** The one who wore the pirate's hat. Colour her trousers. Colour them brown.
- GIRL:** All right. I'm colouring them now.
- MAN:** Thank you.

- MAN:** His friends! Colour the small, square one at the top.
- GIRL:** What colour?
- MAN:** Erm. Colour the smallest present at the top with your blue pencil.
- GIRL:** OK.
- 4 **GIRL:** I'd like to draw something too, please.
- MAN:** Good idea! Draw a spider under the table.
- GIRL:** Under the table. OK! There! Do you like my spider?
- MAN:** Yes. You drew that very well.
- 5 **GIRL:** There were sandwiches and chicken, too!
- MAN:** Can you colour the chicken yellow?
- GIRL:** Yellow is a good colour for chicken! I'm doing that now.
